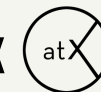

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS



1. The participants are free to choose any theme for their illustration. They must provide a 50-100 word write-up explaining their illustration.
2. Illustrations are to be made on a square artboard, with your URC mentioned on the top right corner.
3. The submission should be compiled in a pdf format (max 5mb), with the Unique Registration code (URC) as the file name and email subject, and mailed to submissions.archzig@gmail.com.

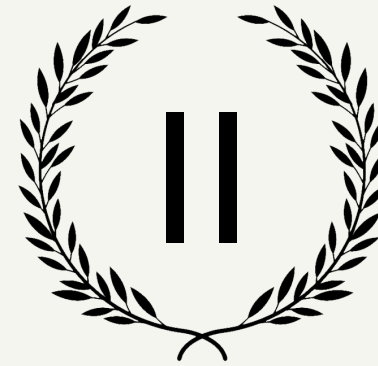

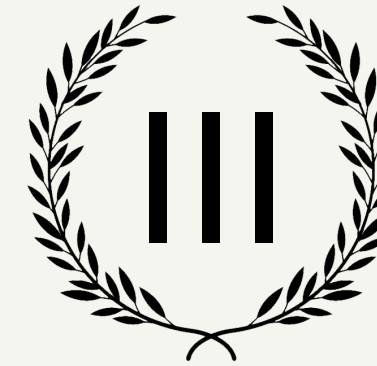

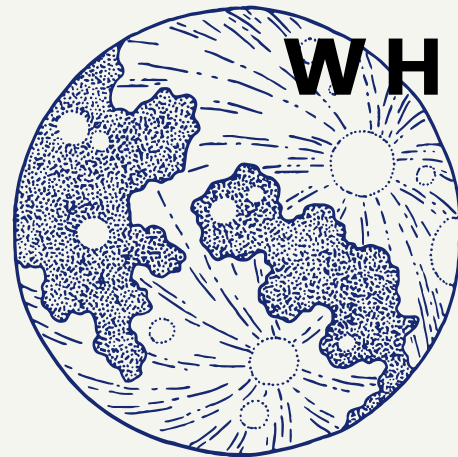

Ten Honorable Mentions : Certificate + Publication

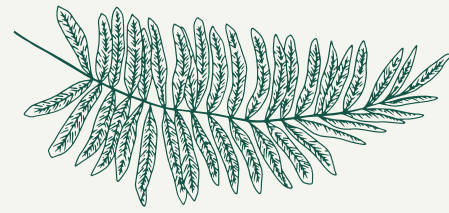
All participants will be awarded Appreciation Certificates.

COMPETITION RULES



1. After completing the registration, you will automatically receive an email from archzig in the email you will find your Unique Registration Code (URC). URC is the only means of identification of the participant as it is an anonymous competition.
2. The registration fee is non refundable. It will only be refunded if the competition is cancelled.
3. Archzig and Architerrax will have the full authority to publish and promote the material, always indicating the author, who will remain the owner of the illustration. By participation in the competition you allow Archzig and Architerrax the right to publish and defuse the received material, and to modify it according to the publications formats.
4. If any form of plagiarism is caught in the competition entry, that entry will be disqualified.
5. Participants will be disqualified if any of the competition rules or submission requirements are not adhered to. Participation assumes acceptance of the regulations.
